

Happy 25th Anniversary, CAA!

This year marks the 25th anniversary of the passage of the Congressional Accountability Act (CAA). On January 23, 1995, the CAA was the first piece of legislation passed by the 104th U.S. Congress. The CAA established an independent office in the legislative branch, now the Office of Congressional Workplace Rights (OCWR), to administer workplace laws promoting safe and accessible workplaces and protecting Congressional staff from unlawful discrimination and harassment.
