Coming Soon: The Congressional Climate Survey

The survey will be used to assess the congressional workplace climate, including incidents of harassment and discrimination. Your participation in the survey will help to ensure that legislative branch employees enjoy a safe, healthy, and productive workplace culture.


Participation is voluntary, and all responses will be completely anonymous and confidential.
